EXCO, Daegu

EXCO Daegu towers five stories above ground, while extending four levels below. It offers state-of-the-art conference rooms, and exhibition halls that accommodate international and domestic conferences as well as grand-scale exhibitions. Remodeled in 2011, the exhibition hall is now 22,159m², the convention hall 3,872m², the auditorium(conference room) 1,581m², and a total of thirty-four conference rooms 5,771m², respectively.

In addition, Daegu EXCO, a total of 29,511m², supports exhibition rooms and conference rooms which makes it possible to hold three medium and grand sized exhibitions, or two grand-scale conferences.
